















LIMEN:Ø – The mirror between physical and digital

An exhibition of phygital art and digital culture for BettyB Festival

Location: Vignola, Modena, Italy

Deadline: September 28, 2025, at 11:59 PM (Italian time)

The mirror is a threshold and a deception, a reflection and a distortion, a portal and a surface. In **LIMEN:**Ø, an exhibition of digital, phygital and new media art for *BettyB Festival 2025*, the concept of the mirror becomes the core device of a visual and symbolic reflection on perception, technology, and alternative realities.

Inspired by Alice's iconic mirror, this open call invites artists to explore the digital as a liminal space, between the physical and the virtual, between what appears and what is altered, inverted, or reimagined. Screens, cameras, sensors, and devices have become our new mirrors: reflective and deforming surfaces, sensitive interfaces connecting us to other dimensions. The mirror is no longer just a symbol, but a threshold to cross, a *limen*, where art becomes a portal to a familiar yet uncanny elsewhere.

We are looking for digital artworks that reflect, invert, or distort the world as we know it: alternative realities, augmented subjectivities, mirror-worlds, ambiguous and visionary experiences that challenge our certainties and invite us to lose ourselves in order to find ourselves again.

Who can apply and how:

- The open call is open to artists of any nationality, without age or background restrictions.
- Proposals from collectives or artistic collaborations are also welcome.
- Each participant (or collective) may submit up to 3 digital works.
- Deadline: September 28, 2025, at 11:59 PM (CET)

Technical requirements:

As works will be displayed **exclusively on screen**, the required formats are:

- Image or video format:
 - Mandatory orientation: 16:9 horizontal or 9:16 vertical

















- Minimum resolution: **1080x1920 px** (or vice versa), 300 DPI/PPI Color: RGB
- Video format: .mp4, max duration 60 seconds
- Image format: .jpg, .png, .tiff
- Required documents (in .doc, .odt, or Google Doc):
 - Full name and/or artist/collective name
 - Title of the work(s)
 - Description (max 1000 characters including spaces)
 - Technique used
 - Artist bio (max 500 characters including spaces)
 - Useful links (portfolio, social media, website)
- Release form submission: All participants are required to complete, sign, and submit the release form with all requested information (Annex 1) for the use and exhibition of the submitted material.
- How to submit:
 - o Create a **Drive folder** (or another cloud folder, NO Wetransfer or similar)
 - Name the folder and all files as:

 - Set sharing permissions to: "Anyone with the link can edit"
